The information provided in this publication is designed to assist Partners, Rally Teams, Event Organisers and other interested parties assess the impact of the 2018 Rally Season from a media and PR perspective.

It is difficult to associate a cost benefit due to the large-scale media penetration achieved by Rally NSW in 2018, but it has been significant.


RALLY NSW MEDIA - QUICK FACTS 2018

In 2018, Rally NSW focused most of its media efforts on covering the MTA NSW Rally Championship and East Coast Classic Rally Series (ECCRS) with Video. The videos were loaded to Facebook, YouTube and the Rally NSW Website. On Facebook alone, the videos received over 210,000 views and 140,000 minutes of viewing time. Approximately 65% of the views were for the MTA NSW Championship and 35% for the East Coast Classic Rally Series. Viewership for the MTA NSW championship videos was approximately 91,000 minutes.


The 2018 Series was launched late in 2017 with the release of two Promotional Videos. These videos were exceptionally popular and started many online conversations about the coming season.



Audience Retention was 81.2% with an average view duration of 1:04 (1:19 total duration), making it exceptionally effective.








There was a total of 215,489 video views (which will continue to increase over time).

Audience Retention

Audience retention is the percentage of a video that a viewer will watch. Typically, retention above 30% is considered to be good. Whilst the 36% average for Round 6 was low, overall minutes viewed was up significantly, with the 15-minute review video having a much higher retention rate.



Engagement – The number of people that interact with the Rally NSW Page has been significant with a reaction peak occurring in August.



The Jake and Elwood rally team decided that 2018 would be the year to 'get the band back together', and they've done it in style, winning four out of the six rounds to take out the 2018 Motor Traders Association NSW Rally Championship.

Taree born Glenn Brinkman, who now lives in Queensland, and Pappinbarra-based co-driver and mechanic Harvey Smith, reunited after many years of not rallying and have been rewarded with a great year.

The two first competed together in 2009 and with a gap of nearly 10 years, decided it was time to do it all again.

"We started this year doing the Queensland series - that didn't go so well -

and came down here to add a few NSW rounds in to get some more time in the car. Things started going pretty well for us, so we stuck with the NSW series - and now we're pretty pleased we did," Brinkman said.

After missing the first NSW round due to family commitments, the team was behind the eight ball for the rest of the series.

The series allowed for only one round of the championship to be dropped so they had no choice but to do well at the remaining five rounds.

Which was exactly what they did with a third outright at the next round and winning the other four rounds to take the series at the final round in

Harvey Smith said it has been a great season.

"Although Glenn has won rallies, I've never won a rally outright before, and now we've won four in a row. It's been a fantastic drive from Glenn and we've had a great time in the car together," he said.

For their first year back in the car together the result has come as quite a surprise. "We've competed in NSW in the past, but it's a whole different game now.

"As a couple of 'old blokes' in rallying, we thought they'd have it all over us. We're pretty surprised but it's been a good reward for the whole year."

DELUGE DAMPENS DECIDER

TORRENTIAL RAIN caused the sixth and final round of the NSW Rally Championship to be shortened, but it didn't stop Glenn Brinkman and Harvey Smith taking both the rally win and the championship on October 20-21.

The victory didn't come without a scare for the Mitsubishi EVO 9 crew. A damaged brake pipe left them with three-wheel brakes for most of a long stage and then no brakes for a few kilometres, after the fluid was pumped out. They ran out winners by just 5s from Tristan Kent and Mike Behnke (EVO 9). Third went to Richard Shimmon and Katie Fletcher (EVO 7), 16s further back.

First 2WD and winner of the inaugural

East Coast Classic Series were Tom Dermody and Eoin Moynihan (Ford Escort BDA). They took a fastest stage time outright (not getting the worst of the rain may have helped) and finished fourth outright.

The route moved south from last year's shire roads to forest stages closer to Bombala and Cooma. The 10 planned stages were cut to eight as violent thunderstorms with torrential rain and hail lashed the forests, turning some of the roads to impassible bogs.

Going into the event, any of the teams of Brinkman/Smith, JJ Haton/Nathan Long (EVO 9), Tom Clarke/Ryan Preston (EVO 9) and Tim Wilkins/Jim Gleeson (EVO 7) could win the championship.

Hatton had a driveshaft fail just into the first stage and was out of heat one. They would restart after repairs, only to have another transmission failure, this one putting them out entirely.

Clarke and Preston were caught in the worst of the storm, reduced to crawling along with 'hail the size of ten-cent coins' hitting the car. Add to this a spin that damaged the exhaust and they were too far behind to make an impression. Fastest time on the last stage was their only consolation.

Wilkins and Gleeson were near the front until their windscreen fogged up, costing nearly 2mins and dropping them to eighth.

struggling, but the last stage I got my voice back." This Saturday things are set to be tougher than last year.

Not only do they face 130 kilometres of competitive racing across three State Forests, but a host of talented rivals.

We are starting a bit further down the field because more drivers from the top end of the competition, Rally Australia, have dropped back down to the state level." Moore said.

Rallying adventure has Trim man on the brink of Australian glory

JJ Hatton has no fear and his passion for extreme sport bears witness to that fact as he currently leads the way in the 2018 Australian NSW Rally Championships.

No stranger to daring endeavours, Hatton climbed Island Peak beside Mount Everest in 2015 and just missed the devastating earthquake that struck Nepal by a matter of days, but that near-miss didn't blunt his enthusiasm for more daring.

Hatton's interest in rallying took off after an exgirlfriend gave him a present of a day's training at a rally school in Australia and the Trim man hasn't looked back since.





"I got into rallying by an ex-girlfriend got me a birthday present a few years back which was a day at rally school here in Australia," he recalled.

"After my day of rallying the instructor then turned to me and said I was the fastest student driver he ever had in his 13 years as a driving instructor.

"After that I had a friend who was a rally driver and he kept pushing me to get a rally car. Other people told me I couldn't do it, but that just made me more determined to succeed. So I dug deep and got a rally car - the rest is history.

"Up until this year I had done a few rallies around Australia. In January of this year I decided I was not only going to commit to the full 2018 rally season, but I was going to attempt to become the 2018 state champion.

"Wishful thinking and very big headed at the time I know, but I was determined and have worked extremely hard and here we are now and it looks like it's possible.

"I even have a post-it stuck on the fridge from that day. Fingers crossed I can bring home the outright trophy for everybody here and at home who support me, even people who fly from Ireland to Australia every year to watch me compete in the World Rally Championship.

"Quentin Ashe from Kiltale has come over every year and then others like David Doyle, John Kane, Derek Walsh, Colin McKay who are all Trim men living in Australia and other friends from all over Australia all come to support me and fly the Meath flag.

"For all those people who got a lift off me back in the day in Trim at least my driving has amounted to something useful," joked Hatton.

Known in Australian rallying circles as the 'Crazy Irishman', Trim native Hatton is a real character with a passion for rallying.

Hatton is no stranger to the Rally community, having entered previous NSW championship seasons and has also been seen at selected rounds of the Australian Rally Championship and other local club events. Mixed results in 2016 hampered Hatton's chance at a championship win. At the 2016 Rally of the Bay, he went in with great expectations, but a broken gear cable and an encounter with a tree and a small bank, would see them sidelined and disappointed.

Earlier in 2016, Hatton saw better results at the VolksMuller Rallysprint held in the Sydney International Dragway precinct at Eastern Creek in Sydney's west.

Some exceptional driving and consistent fast times across the day would see him finish third outright in dusty conditions on a very dry Sydney weekend.

The J-Sport team started the 2017 season by doing the blind, non pace-note, Caves Classic Rally, but once

again, there was no luck for the Irish and after moving up to fourth, Hatton was forced to withdraw.

After such a disappointing end to the 2016 running of the Rally of the Bay, Hatton and the J-Sport team were back for the 2017 Rally of the Bay and hoping for a better result.

Consistently clean driving throughout the event and a focused drive would be rewarded, and by the end of the night stage, Hatton had secured second outright.

After such a strong finish, the next rally would see Hatton step up and enter not only the NSW and Australian Championship rounds, but also take on the world's best at Rally Australia for the 2017 World

Rally Championship event.

Some flamboyant driving would ensure the J-Sport team were a crowd favourite and consistent stage times kept Hatton and his Evo 9 in the top 20, but not everything went his way.

Day two saw Hatton and a lot of the field damage their cars on a bridge section and subsequently drop back down the field. Ultimately, on day three, two punctures and with only one spare in the car, Hatton would withdraw two stages from the end.

The experience of the demanding three-day WRC outing inspired the J-Sport team to commit to the full 2018 MTA NSW Championship and that is not a decision Hatton has regretted.

"I took up rallying for a bit of fun and because people told me I couldn't do it. Now a few years later and I'm committing to the full NSW Rally Championship season for 2018, it has been hectic, but I'm loving every solit second of it." said the Trim man.

"Amazingly I started off this year as number one seeded car and I'd like to thank all the people who got me to this point and the Australian Rally community for letting me in and helping me out in every which

way that was required. Great bunch of people and car clubs.
"Despite cleaning the roads as number one seed I'm currently leading the championship after four round which have been run all over the country.

which have been run all over the country.
"I'm only ahead by two points so it will come down to the wire. If I succeed I will be the first Irish man to

win the Australia NSW State Championship."
Even competing at such a high level is a remarkable achievement for Hatton. However, he is not just holding his own, he is actually leading the charge - and all on a very low budget compared to many of the

Thorough its own, it is account reading the charge "and an on a very low budget companied to many of the other drivers he competes against.

"Considering I only have a shoe -string budget compared to some teams I'm probably far exceeding

expectations of those who follow NSW Rallying. My car is probably worth \$30,000 compared to some of the other cars which would be worth \$700,000" he said.

"I still have a lot of local help with sponsorship from all over Meath who own businesses here in Australia.

All Meath men of course. Eddie Shanley who is piling contractor from Enfield, Derek Mullally is a construction contractor from Ballinlough and Paul Garvey a bricklaying contractor from Kiltale all give me great support," concluded the Trim driver who is on the verge of creating history.
